Sanofi collaborates with VeryNile to empower Qursaya Island community through environmental sustainability activities

Cairo, Egypt – 10 February, 2023. Sanofi Egypt, collaborates with VeryNile to engage with diverse communities, with the objective of shedding awareness on the importance of protecting the environment in which we live.

This project aims at cleaning the Nile River, recycling waste, in addition to supporting vulnerable communities in Qursaya Island. Generally, the island hosts around 250 families, who are mostly underprivileged farmers and marginalized fishermen with a limited access to job opportunities.

As for Sanofi's part, the company will financially contribute to VeryNile to upgrade its operational facility within Qursaya, purchase the necessary equipment, and work on training and hiring fishermen and operators, so as to secure a stable income for its inhabitants, as well as raise their standard of living.

Additionally, the project aims at decreasing the pollution that surrounds the Nile by 2030, raising awareness on protecting the environment, and turning Qursaya into the first zero-waste locality in Egypt.

This collaboration came at the end of last year with Sandrine Bouttier Stref, Global Head of CSR Sanofi, Ghada Michel, Sanofi Egypt Communication and CSR Head, as well as Alban de Ménonville, Managing Director of VeryNile.

We volunteering 2nd wave

with the beginning of the year of 2023, Sanofi employees have joined forces prioritizing social work where they cleaned up the nile from 50 Kg plastic wastes. Then collaborated with the island's inhabitants within the same day in manual handcrafts producing products from recyclable plastic giving around 42 useful products.

Climate Action

As part of Sanofi's ongoing efforts to fight climate change, the company aims to collect 15 tons monthly on an annual basis (180 tons annually), as well as support 120 fishermen and 12 operators for waste recycling by the end of this year. Also, Sanofi's vision for this project lies in encouraging more of its employees to volunteer to clean the Nile, in several waves reducing the plastic pollution in the Mediterranean Sea and the Nile, and finally creating the first zero-waste community in Egypt.
