Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs), also called chronic diseases, are long duration diseases with generally slow progression. The main types of NCDs are cardiovascular diseases (CVD), cancer, chronic respiratory diseases, diabetes and mental disorders.

For more than 20 Years, Project **HOPE** and Sanofi Specialty Care have been working together to improve the health and well-being of those living with Gaucher disease in Egypt by providing essential medicines, health care worker education and support to families with approximately 132 patients undergoing active treatment at seven university children's hospitals across the country through donations of Enzyme replacement therapy (ERT).

This project has contributed to substantial improvements to better understand the disease burden and consequently management from diagnosis and treatment perspectives.

Sanofi's Rare Humanitarian Program is also providing free ERT therapy for 14 Pompe disease patients in Egypt.

Started in **2003**, aimed to support Egyptian community to early screen and detect diabetes and also aimed to enhance Egyptian diabetic patients' compliance and adherence to diabetes treatment and ensured that patients is living a full, healthy life with diabetes *Zabat Sokarak* included *42 educators*, a dedicated hotline and supported *active 40,000* diabetic.



In 2015, Sanofi Egypt inaugurated a new state of the art distribution center. in Cairo's 6th of October City aimed to better serve Egyptian market needs by almost doubling the storage capacity from 6800 pallets to 12000 pallets and by improving delivery time to market.

The distribution center complies with Health, Safety and Environment requirements. It is designed to secure storage and delivery of more than a hundred of pharmaceutical products in different therapeutic areas while respecting the highest quality stan-
