INDIA AT PARIS OLYMPICS

Menacing Manu, sensational Sen off to solid starts on day 1

No Olympic medal in shooting since 2012; Bhaker well placed

PRESS TRUST OF INDIA Chateauroux/Paris, July 27

MANU BHAKER MADE a statement of intent by storming into the 10m air pistol finals on a day when most of her compatriots endured a forgettable outing at the shooting range before shutter Lakshya Sen and paddler Harmeet Desai dazzled on debut in India's sedate start at the Olympic Games on Saturday. Bhaker, who is competing in her second Olympics, seemed determined to wipe off the memories of her tearful past outing as she qualified third for the 10m air pistol women's final which will be held on Sunday afternoon at the Chateauroux Shooting Centre.

In the badminton competition being held at the Porte de La Chapelle Arena in Paris, Sen was in a hurry to wrap up the proceedings but Guatemala's Kevin Cordón made sure that the Indian was stretched to an extent in his opening Group L match. Sen prevailed 21-8 22-20 after saving four match points in a tenacious performance. At the South Paris Arena, seasoned campaigner Desai, also competing in his first Olympics, added some more sparkle to

India's performance by progressing to the men's singles second round with a convincing 4-0 victory over Jordan's Zaid Abo Yaman.

The shooters have drawn a blank at every Olympics after 2012 and the apprehensions began to set in early for this one too before Bhaker decided to take control. The 22-year-old, who hails from Jhajjar in Haryana, shot 580 in the qualifications in which Hungarian ace Veronika Major claimed the top spot with a score of 582. The other Indian in the field, Rhythm Sangwan, ended 15th with an underwhelming 573. Bhaker, who was in control for the major part of the one hour 15 minute session, will have to maintain the same composure in the all-important final. India has not won an Olympic medal in shooting since 2012 and Bhaker is well placed to end that lean run.

Harris makes it official; gap with Trump narrows

VICE PRESIDENT KAMALA Harris on Saturday officially signed her forms, declaring her candidacy for the post of President of the US and voiced confidence that she would win the high-stakes election on November 5. "Today, I signed the forms officially declaring my candidacy for President of the United States. I will work hard to earn every vote," 59-year-old Harris, who is of Indian and African origin, said. "In November, our people-powered campaign will win," the presumptive Democratic Party candidate said, referring to her electoral battle with former president and the Republican Party's nominee Donald Trump. Harris launched her presidential campaign last Sunday, hours after President Joe Biden, 81, withdrew from the race for a second term. She is, however, yet to be officially declared as the presidential candidate by the Democrats.

If elected on November 5 to succeed President Biden, Harris would not only be the first woman, but the first Indian-American, the first Asian, the first Black woman and the first person of Jamaican descent to ascend to the office. Harris has narrowed the gap with Donald Trump. An NYT/Siena poll found that Harris had closed the gap by 6 or 7 percentage points, depending on whether third parties are included. Her gain comes largely from parts of the Democratic coalition that had soured on Biden.

South China Sea lines critical for Indo-Pacific peace: EAM

EXTERNAL AFFAIRS MINISTER S Jaishankar on Saturday stressed the need for a substantive and effective code of conduct to secure sea lines of communication in the South China Sea which he said are critical for peace and stability of the Indo-Pacific region, amidst growing concerns about China's maritime coercion.

Addressing the 14th East Asia Summit (EAS) Foreign Ministers Meeting in Laos's capital Vientiane, Jaishankar said the EAS process will complete two decades next year and India will contribute towards a stronger EAS process. He said India will continue to uphold ASEAN unity and centrality through our Act East Policy. Talking about maritime security, Jaishankar said: the "Sea Lines of Communication (SLOC) passing through the South China Sea are critical for peace, stability, prosperity and development of the Indo-Pacific region."

Jaishankar's comments hold significance as his Chinese counterpart Wang Yi is also in Vientiane to attend the summit. The resource-rich South China Sea in the Indo-Pacific region is widely seen as a potential flash-point for global conflict. China claims most of the South China Sea as its own, while The Philippines, Vietnam, Malaysia, Brunei and Taiwan have counterclaims over the maritime area. The South China Sea provides shipping routes connecting Northeast Asia with Southeast Asia and West Asia. Southeast Asian countries are trying to reach an agreement with China on a code of conduct to avert confrontations in the South China Sea.

ASEAN Regional Forum on Saturday alongside diplomats of major powers including Russia, India, Blinken singled out China over its coast guard's hostile actions against US defence ally, the Philippines, in the sea

Biles leads charge of older gymnasts at Olympics redefining their sport

IT STILL HAPPENS to Simone Biles. Even now, after two Olympics, six world championships, and a decade-plus in the spotlight.

The most decorated gymnast of all time and the face of the US Olympic movement will be chatting with someone when her age comes up.

"They're like Oh my god, you're so cute, you're a kid" Biles told *The Associated Press* with a somewhat exasperated laugh. "Like I want to say I'm grown. I'm an adult now. I'm 27 years old." Yet, the perception of Biles as a pony-tailed prodigy persists even as the demographics at the top of her sport shift.



Maybe, it's because all but one of the last 13 Olympic champions have been teenagers, including Biles when she triumphed in Rio de Janeiro eight years ago and US teammate and good friend Sunisa Lee, who was 18 when she edged Brazilian star Rebeca Andrade in a taut final in Tokyo in 2021. They're both back on what they've labelled a "redemption tour." When Biles and Lee step onto the floor at Bercy Arena on Sunday for Olympic qualifying, they'll be joined by 2020 Olympic floor champion Jade Carey (24) and 2020 Olympic

silver medallist Jordan Chiles (23) along with newcomer Hezly Rivera, at 16 by far the youngest member of the oldest team the Americans have ever sent to the Games. Gone are the days when six-time Olympic medallist Aly Raisman was dubbed the team grandma in 2016 at all of 22, a moniker Biles jokingly admitted she now needs to apologise for using.

"Like, I'm ancient now," Biles said. "Forget grandma, we're past that." Improved training, the easing of rules around name, image and likeness rights for college athletes, and the power of social media are allowing the top Americans to extend their careers.
