

In trials, GM Mustard's yield against peers under scanner

The potential yield of the genetically modified (GM) Mustard hybrid, DMH-II against the next best variety in some of the government-sanctioned trial sites has not been very clearly established, according to people in the know. Its weight has also been discovered to be lower in the first special trial conducted in ICAR (Indian Agricultural Research Institute) facilities, sources said.

The DMH-II does give a per hectare yield of 2.6 tonnes as claimed by the developers, sources at the six field trials done last season confirmed, but how it fares compared to other varieties at the testing sites isn't very clear yet.

Sources said that according to ICAR's protocols under All India Coordinated Research Project on Rapeseed and Mustard, mustard hybrids that are being tested should give at least 5 per cent more yield than its competing best performing hybrid variety planted alongside the test variety. It should also give 10 per cent more yield than the competing check variety planted alongside the variety being tested.

In case of DMH-II, the variety was planted alongside six other competing varieties to test its yield and other potentials in different locations across India, which would have opened the door for commercial release.

But sources said both in case of its yield potential and weight, the hybrid seemed to

Govt begins kharif paddy procurement

The government has started procuring paddy and about 1.221 million tonnes of the grain has been purchased from farmers at minimum support price (MSP) so far, according to the food ministry. The harvesting of kharif paddy this year started last week.

State-owned Food Corporation of India (FCI) sold 189,000 tonnes of wheat and only 5,000 tonnes of rice to bulk consumers in the 15th weekly e-auction held on Wednesday. Wheat and rice are being sold under the Open Market Sale Scheme (OMSS) to bulk users to cool down retail prices.

not performing as expected in some trial sites. "The findings of the first special trials would be submitted to the Supreme Court and more details on whether the yield claims have met the protocols in all sites would become clearer," sources said. In case of weight of the

seed, sources said according to the protocols, mustard hybrids should have a weight of 4.5 grams per 1,000 seeds, but DMH-II's weight is only 3.5 grams. The current best mustard hybrid that is widely used by farmers across India has a weight of 5-5.5 grams per 1,000 seeds.

Low weight seeds make it difficult for mechanised harvesting of mustard crops, which is now widely prevalent across the country.

"Low weight mustard seeds tend to blow away during mechanised harvesting and hence aren't preferred by farmers across the northern belt where it is widely grown," sources said.

Sources added that the not so suitable findings in the first large-scale special field trials of DMH-II in the official system could hinder journey on to the second stage.

This is because for further trials, seeds have to be planted at least by the first week of November to get ideal results. Some said the sub-par yield compared to competing varieties could be attributed to the delayed sowing but the delay was faced by all varieties that were planted, sources said.

The Supreme Court is slated to hear the case of DMH-II on October 10 where it could take a call on whether it wants to go ahead with further trials or not.

The spike in the per hectare mustard yields from an average 1-1.3 tonnes is one of the biggest positives that pro-GM groups cite for adoption of new DMH-II, apart from reduction in use of pesticide and other harmful chemicals.

On the questions of how better or inferior it is compared to the next best competing varieties, those pro-GM say that the DMH-II is just a stepping stone towards achieving even higher yields as the technology could be further used to enhance yields.



CHEAPER TOMATO PULLS DOWN PRICE OF VEG THALI BY 17%

Indians have had to shell out 17 per cent lesser money to feast on a vegetarian thali in September compared to last month, according to an analysis done by analytics firm CRISIL. The fall in tomato prices, which declined 62 per cent month-on-month (M-o-M) to ₹39 a kg in September from ₹102 a kg in August, was the major contributor. Onion prices, meanwhile, rose by 12 per cent in September and are expected to remain firm amid the expected lower output in kharif 2023, CRISIL said. The cost of a non-vegetarian thali declined nine per cent M-o-M due to a 2-3 per cent estimated monthly increase in prices of broiler chicken, which has more than 50 per cent share in the total thali cost. This seems to have negated the impact of falling vegetable prices.

Andhra Pradesh shelves plan to frame law on legalising MSP

In an apparent reversal of its move, the Andhra Pradesh government has decided to shelve its plan of legislation to guarantee minimum support price (MSP) for farmers, which reportedly had clauses that included heavy penalties and jail terms for violators.

The state is expected to come up with a reworked Bill in this regard, top sources said. The government has decided to shelve the current draft Bill on guaranteeing MSP and rework it, said two sources aware about the development.

Though the officials did not give any reason for shelving the plan, sources said top political authorities in the state were not comfortable with the draft's content and wanted a second look at it.

The Bill was expected to be introduced in the next session of the Assembly.

Earlier this month, reports quoting state Agriculture Minister Kakani Govardhana Reddy had indicated that a judicial review committee was looking at the draft Bill.

According to reports, the Bill was titled "the Andhra Pradesh Farmers' Produce Support Price Act, 2023". It defined MSP to be a price set by the state but which would not be lower than the Centre-determined MSP. It also said the MSP notified under the Act was enforceable for any transactions in the state with regard to farmers' produce, irrespective of whether this transaction happened within mandis, cooperative societies, or any other collectives. According to reports, it also provided for a penalty of ₹50,000 for entering into

any transaction below the MSP for the first time. It will go up to ₹1 lakh and there will be imprisonment for up to six months for subsequent violations.

This Bill and similar moves have been a contentious issue with stakeholders, and experts have pointed towards the market-distorting nature of such proposals. A few years ago, in one of its price reports, the Commission for Agriculture Costs and Prices (CACPC), the body which sets the MSP for 23 kharif and rabi crops, had suggested bringing in legis-

lation titled "Right to Sell at MSP", which would give legal backing to the exercise and ensure that no one purchased crops below the fixed mandated price. The recommendation was never pursued thereafter.

In August 2018, the Maharashtra government under then chief minister Devendra Fadnis decided to amend the state Agricultural Produce Market Committee Act, making it illegal for a private trader to purchase agricultural produce below the government-fixed MSP. The amendment said any trader who failed to purchase farm goods at MSP could be sent to jail for a year or be compelled to pay a fine of ₹50,000. "The problem with legalising MSP is ensuring that private players follow the guidelines. It can be done wherever government purchases take place. Also such moves are against market-makers," S Mahendra Dev, former director and vice-chancellor of the Indra Gandhi Institute of Development Research, Mumbai, told Business Standard.
